One of the busiest ever one day Elsecar Shows with an increased visitor attendance - the hall bustling from 8.30 right up to the auction finish. Many commented on the high quality of stock (lots of "fresh to market" material), and plenty of new finds in the 2 Antique Centres. In the Coddswallop museum those who made the effort were rewarded with a spectacular new Co-operative ceramics/ go-withs exhibition, and other new "installations" in this now highly worthwhile additional visitor attraction that many still appear to overlook/ forget.

The whole event was tarnished with the theft of the hat from lot 385 during viewing. AB threatened CCTV footage at the National unless it is returned (postally?) very quickly? This will now mean restricted viewing for everyone, after 26+ years of unspoilt trust - very sad. For another lot one potential customer was put off when one of the top lots was branded "repro", presumably for devious reasons?

An excellent spread of top notch pieces in the sale, some very good prices (the rarest/ best/ mint still at the forefront of collectors requirements), and a good range of bargains to keep the dedicated glued to their seats.

Hindsight is a great thing - but close scrutiny will reveal how worthwhile it can be to sit throughout the whole proceedings. But it is not only the Bottle, Pot Lid, & Advertising fields which remain very much a buyers (highly selective) market - if the goods meet current collectors tastes/ requirements a good price is assured, otherwise its anyone's guess.
