**Saturday** A really good crowd assembled to gain part of the action from the super varied/mixed material for the Uncatalogued auction. Lots of bargains, some good prices, for stallholders and individual collectors .... but all this didn't keep Surrey's Clive Wicks awake?

**Sunday** Another superb stallholder turn-out, plus a constantly lively and busy show - all day. Almost 600 braved 'suspect' weather conditions - Iain Gosling leaving a snowbound Aberdeen region, travelling through bands of snow, and slowed down by a blizzard almost 30 miles from Elsecar. Bad weather **DOES NOT** at home after Saturdays heavy downfall.

*Herewith a resume of realisations - provided with ALL add ons:*

No significant col'd Pratt types - almost 3 dozen reflecting the evident weakness of the lower part of this field. The rare b & w Wrightons @ £410 seems about right with minor damage, as did the Rimmels (under flange chip) @ £155.

**Pipes Collection** No significant offerings - primarily mixed groups - damage again very clearly effecting lowly competition, and price.

**GB's** The green topped, unique, Buenos Aries stuttered ... but nudged up to a good £375.

**Miniatures Collection** Four lots stood out as fairly significant - Doulton Jas. Lewis filter £1050, 1897 dated Mortlock impressed jug £300, same for the Taddy snuff (flake), Price & Sons flagon £285.

**Night Lights Collection** The better glass saw a pair of crowns @ £155, pale yellow shade Clarkes £126, 3 pretty freeblown colours £105. Both pottery heads performed about right - £125 for the owl/ cat/ dog head, and £100 for the baby's head.

**Cures & Poisons** No great shocks: Warners - 2 pt red amber (bruised) £185, olive Diabetes pt £300, olive Nervine pt £150. Dalby's pontilled £105. 6 ins. Wilsons NO DAMAGE £380. Blue & white male urinal £390. Drug run drawer fronts (glass) 18 £170. Wall mounted dentists table £265.

**Ointments** Mrs Gares £710. Scurvy £92. Stone Salve £80. Pr Prof. Phelps £80.

**Eyebaths** No great shakers or rarities, evenly contested throughout.

**Minerals** Cellar found 6oz green Scarboro & Whitby £115, same price for an Inman Bros valve (low lugs).

**Miscellaneous** Giant labelled Roses lime juice £205. English onion (lip chip, wear) £205. Artware Doulton SCOTCH dispenser £1,890 - try finding another! Two of the scarcely seen Ballemoney creams were offered here (sepai & black) making £70. The day before 2 pairs (same digger) made £105 and £65 respectively .... the BEST 2 come up in the Kitchenalia sale - then they are all gone again - off the scene .... anyone like to hazard a guess?
