Then congrats. to the Oxford Club for their splediferous Club Display, and £100 cash prize. Then the auction Once more it was rarities, and/or tip top condition 'classics', which evidenced the strongest competition - interspersed with a few bargains too! Best performers were undoubtedly the Oxford cylinder (£1,825), the Keswick amber dumpy (£3,650), the sealed bladder (£4,790) ... then the much handled, much admired, much speculated Matchless enamel - final hammer £7,760 - a reasonable return on the £9 cost from a 1970's monthly Bury Bottle Club meeting?

As mixed and varied a selection as we've ever had for a SummerNational auction - plenty there for both the serious collector or those who (like me) just want a momento from the 2006 event!
